<p>COOK'S</p>  <p>CORNER</p>	<p>Swedish Meatballs</p> <p>¾ pound lean ground beef ½ pound ground veal ¼ pound ground pork 1 ½ cups soft bread crumbs 1 cup light cream *** ½ cup chopped onions 1 tsbl butter or margarine 1 egg ¼ cup finely snipped parsley 1 ¼ tsp salt Dash pepper-ground ginger-ground nutmeg 2 tsbl butter or margarine for gravy</p> <p>Have meats ground together twice. Soak bread in cream about 5 minutes. Cook onion in 1 tsbl butter till tender but not brown. Mix meats, crumb mixture, onion, egg, parsley, and seasonings. Beat 5 minutes at medium speed on mixer, or mix by hand until well combined. Shape into 1 ½ -inch balls. (Mixture will be soft-for easier shaping, wet hands or chill mixture first). Brown meatballs in 2 tsbl butter. Remove from skillet. For gravy: melt 2 tsbl butter in skillet with drippings. Stir in 2 tsbl all-purpose flour. Add 1 beef bouillion cube dissolved in 1 ¼ cup of boiling water and ½ tsp instant coffe power. Cook and stir until gravy thickens. Add meatballs. Cover; cook slowly about 30 minutes; baste occasionally. Makes 30 meatballs.</p>

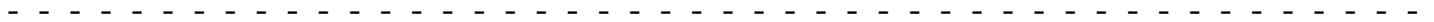
Are you a Reporter? Want to Write?

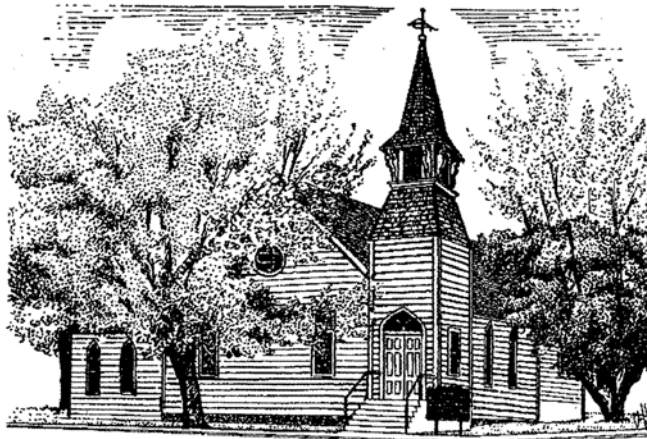
