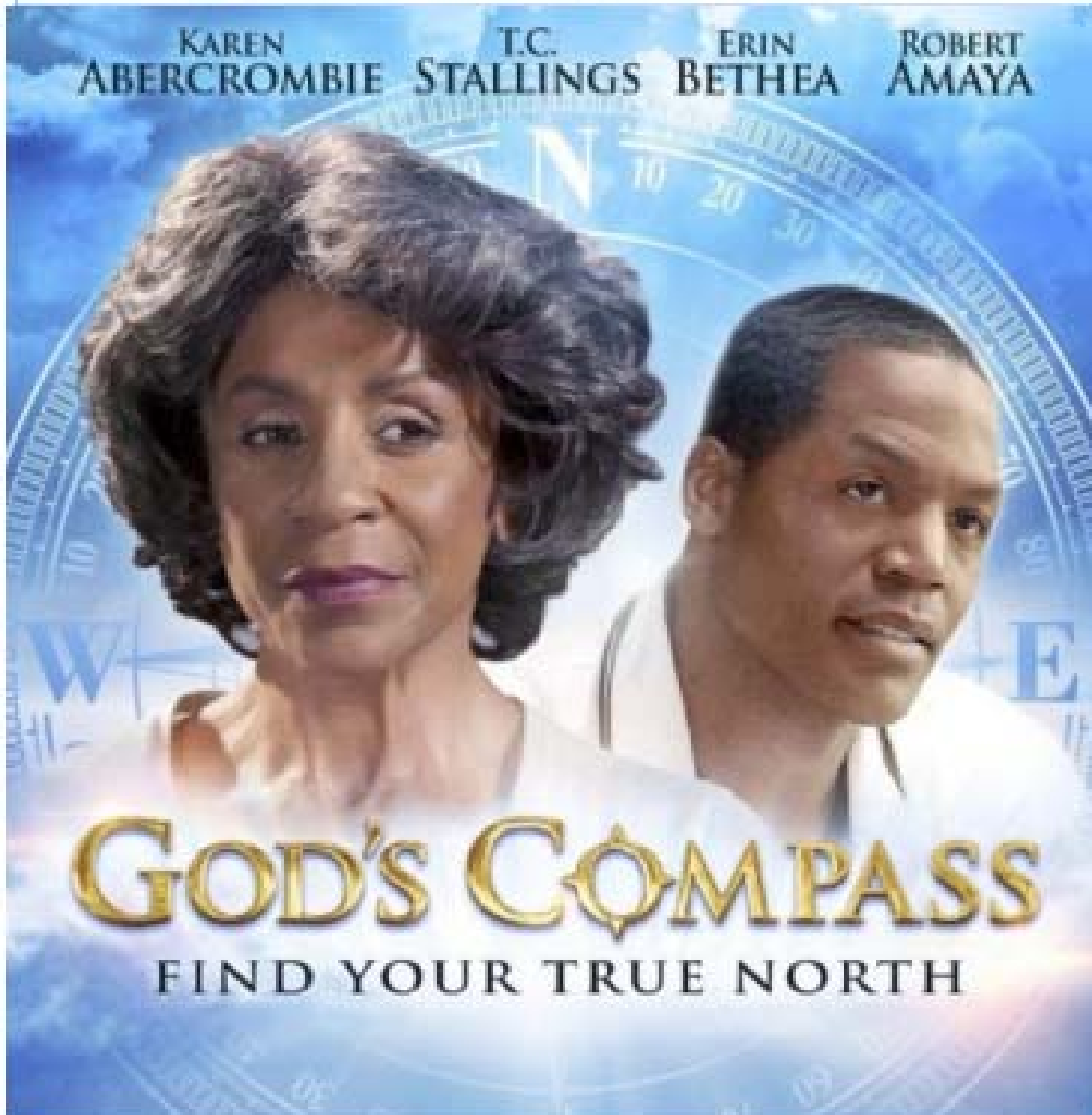

Wonton Sausage Appetizers

- 25- wonton wrappers
- 1 lb. sausage, cooked and well drained
- 1 ½ cups cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 cup pepper jack cheese
- ¾ cup ranch dressing

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Press a wonton wrapper into each cup of a muffin tin. Bake for 5 minutes. Remove from oven and place wonton “cups” on a cookie sheet. Repeat until there are about 25 cups. Mix sausage, cheddar, cheese, pepper jack cheese, and dressing until well blended. Spoon mixture into wontons. Bake 5 to 10 minutes, or until bubbly. Makes 25

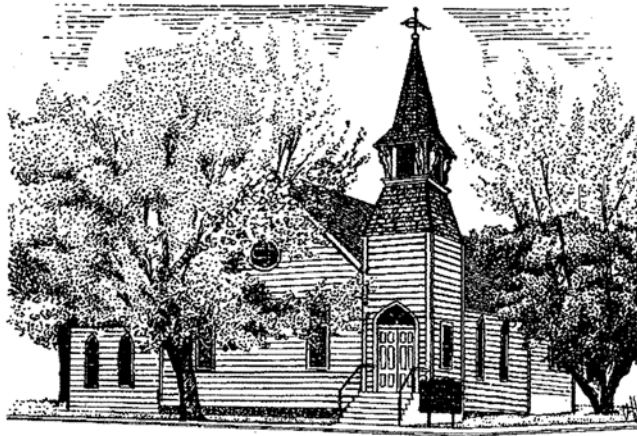
